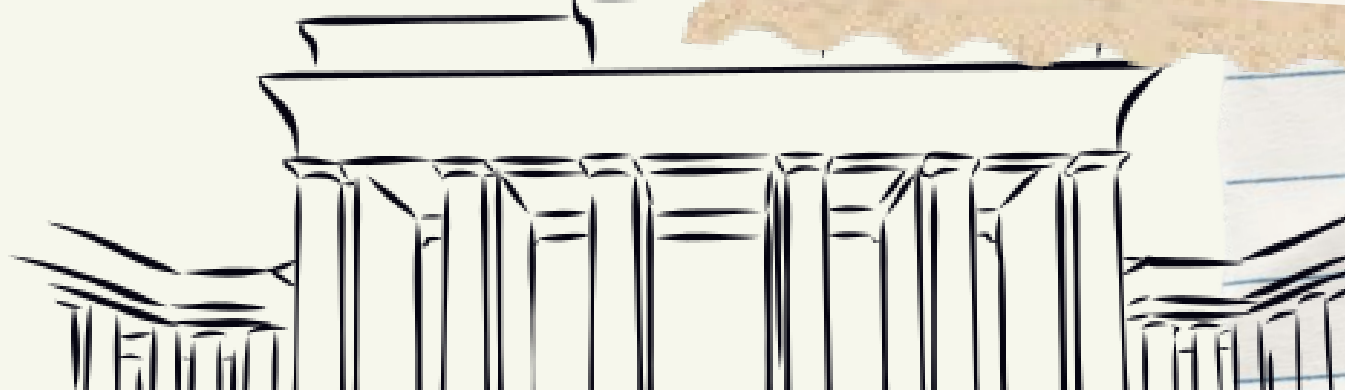






# History of Germany

# Natural Life in Germany

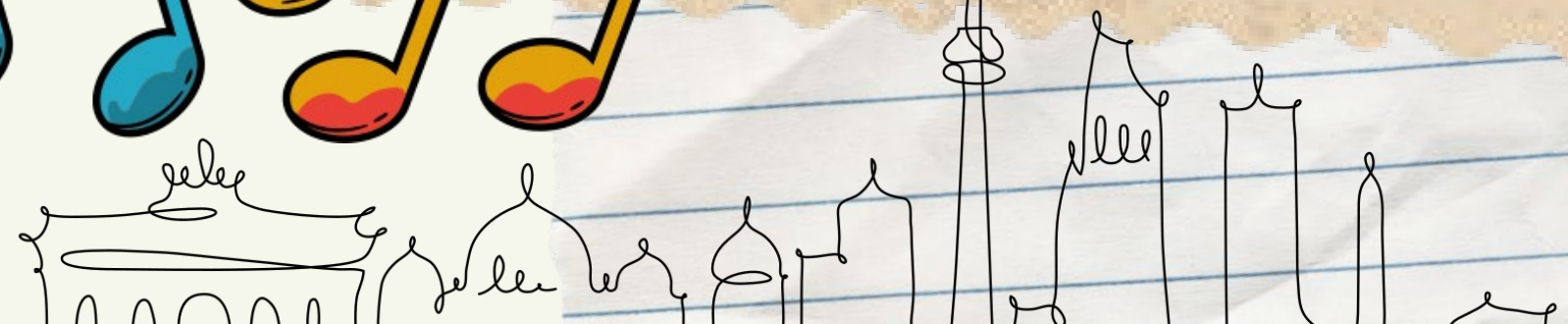

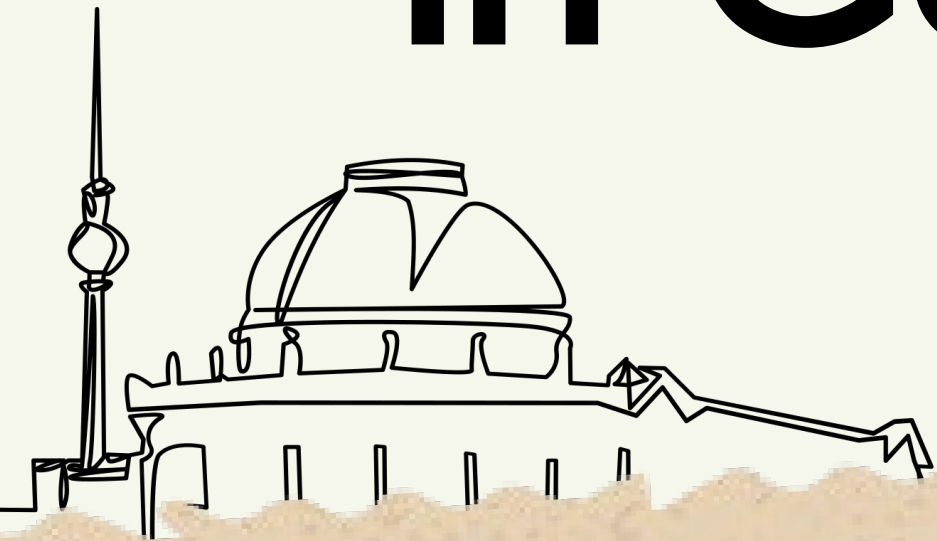






# Natural Life in Germany
