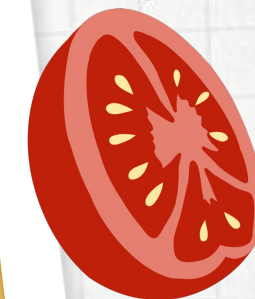
Wildlife in Spain

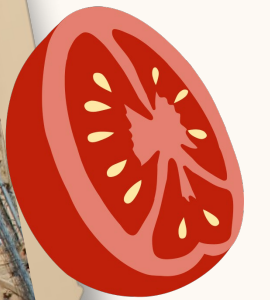
Sports in Spain
